



Espoo will prepare a city-wide master plan that will reach all the way to 2060 (City Board meeting on 20 June 2022, section 220).

Espoo has grown faster than predicted, and it is necessary to assess which parts of the master plan need to be revised. The up-to-date, recent partial master plans will remain in force in their respective areas, but they will also be integrated into the full master plan in terms of scale and presentation

The master plan is a general land use and transport plan to manage Espoo's growth in a sustainable way, in line with the Espoo Story. The master plan is drawn up in stages in cooperation with residents, stakeholders and experts, and approved by the City Council The master plan directs local detailed planning and other more detailed plan

## **Current legislation in Finland (MRL)**

In Finland those on whose living, working or other conditions the plan may have a substantial impact must have the opportunity to participate in preparing the plan, estimate its impact and state their opinion on it, in writing or orally.

§63

Participation and assessment scheme: When a plan is being drawn up, a scheme covering participation and interaction procedures and assessment of the plan's impact must be drawn up in good time, as required by the purpose and the significance of the plan.

The initiation of the planning process must be publicized so that **interested parties have the opportunity to obtain information on the principles of the planning and of the participation and assessment procedure.** Such publicity must be arranged in a manner appropriate to the purpose and significance of the plan. The publicity may also take place in connection with the publication of a planning review.



Finlex: Land use and building act (132/1999)

### Proposals for amendments to the law

"As an addition to the current provisions on the participation and assessment plan, it is proposed that **it would also describe other plans to be drawn up for the implementation of the plan**, including the issues to be addressed and the timetable, if known. This would include, for example, plans for streets and other public areas. The participation and assessment plan should also indicate if it is known at the time of its preparation that **land use agreements** will be drawn up to implement the plan..

It is also proposed that the parties concerned should be given the opportunity to express their views on the participation and assessment plan. A summary of the opinions expressed and their impact on the objectives, starting points and other contents of the participation and assessment plan should be drawn up and made available to the parties concerned as part of the preparatory documentation for the next stages of the plan. This procedure would strengthen the interaction at the early stages of the preparation of the plan and would make it clearer how effective it is to express an opinion."

"Participants should have the opportunity to express their views on the content, impacts and evidence base of the key choices and options in the preparation of the plan, as ap propriate to its purpose and significance, during the preparation process, before the content and planning solutions are finalised into a draft plan."

The legislative reform is still underway for land use planning, so we do not know whether these changes will be implemented.

The digitalisation of planning will also have an impact on the participation and assessment shceme.

An information model for the OAS is being planned, which would mean a more precise definition and regulation of the content.


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
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

### PPP Course work: Participation and assessment scheme 2.0

#### Osallistumis- ja arviointisuunnitelma (OAS) Public Participation Plan (PPP)

Participation and assessment schemes are drawn up at the start of the planning process, to define how citizens, organizations and other interest groups can contribute to the whole process. Such co-operation begins during the initial phase of the planning process, while alternatives are still open, to allow participants to genuinely influence the plans. Assignment: How would you arrange public participation in a planning case?


- Select real or imaginary urban planning case
- <u>Design ideal participation</u> process (e.g., methods and tools) for the planning case
- Use course literature to justify your approach
- <u>Develop a PPP</u>: The format of the work is free. You can combine texts, visualizations, webpages, videos etc. in your work.




