Final project outline

Produce a rough outline (see e.g. <u>https://writingcenter.gmu.edu/writing-resources/writing-as-process/outlining</u>) of the proposed project, including **country choice**, country specific **subsection titles**, initial **bibliography** and **some bullets** under relevant sections reflecting the lectures, readings, and your initial thoughts.

<u>Avoid</u> being too general, the outline is supposed to demonstrate your early research on the chosen country. <u>Structure</u> your thoughts and readings in, and to, the outline structure, so that it makes a coherent and logical whole. <u>Cover</u> in the outline the full breadth of the assignment. Bibliography should mainly consist of <u>peer-reviewed</u> papers, rather than grey literature. Popular media sources (e.g. BBC, HS, New York Times) should be completely avoided, as should wikipedia.

Marked 5 for doing what is asked, 3 if minor gaps exist, 1 if problems/gaps severe and 0 if no submission/no real attempt to do what is asked. Note that your final project can differ from the outline, for both country and/or sector, although that does reduce the benefits of doing the outline.
