## The use of AI for the assignments

## For this course:

- 1. The use AI is not forbidden.
- 2. Students are fully responsible for the text, and factual errors will be penalized, whether introduced by the AI or the student. AI tends to produce text that looks good but is less strong on the facts.
- 3. Any non-trivial arguments require (peer reviewed) references to support them, or own argumentation that starts from a reference or a well-known fact. Note that AI may invent references, which is the same as the student inventing a reference (see 2. above)
- 4. If the AI plagiarizes text and the student uses it as is, the student plagiarizes text. Note also that the Aalto guidelines say "However, AIgenerated text cannot be presented as is as the student's own written response."
- 5. If you have used AI, provide a short statement about how you used it (statement does not contribute towards the word count).
