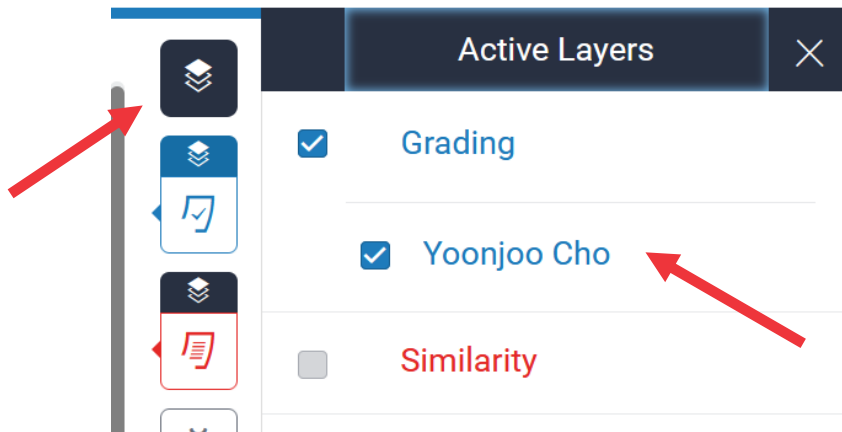

Reminder: the day of the debate

Pre-debate 5mins warm-up:

- Go over your team's position (points, refutations, etc.) to refresh your memories and get geared up

Debate ~45-55 mins:

- Chairperson takes over; teams start debating; POIs from the opposing team (each speaker needs to accept at least 1 POI during their speeches if they are offered)

Post-debate 5-10 min cool-down:

- Audience questions
- Each team member shares immediate impressions of performance, audience & teacher respond by giving some of their own feedback based on their written feedback

While you listen & watch, give a little written feedback on the handout provided

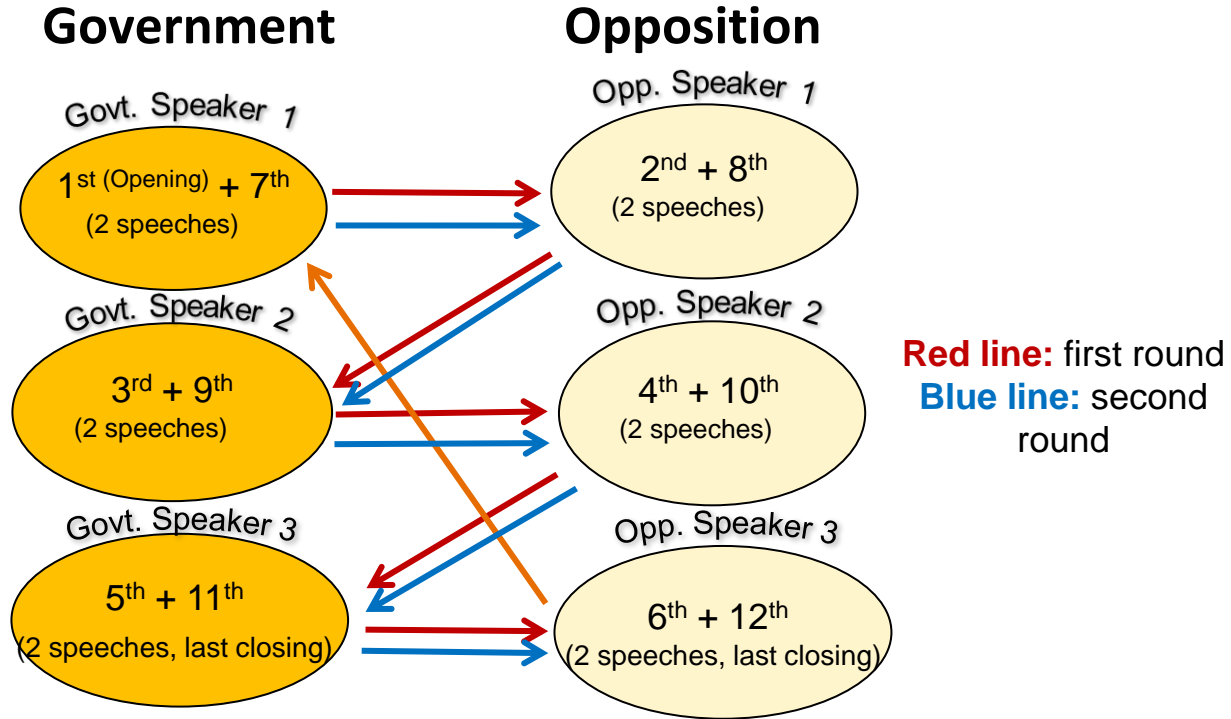
- Content, Structure & Strategy, Style & Delivery

... deciding which team (Govt or Opp) you think won and WHY you think so

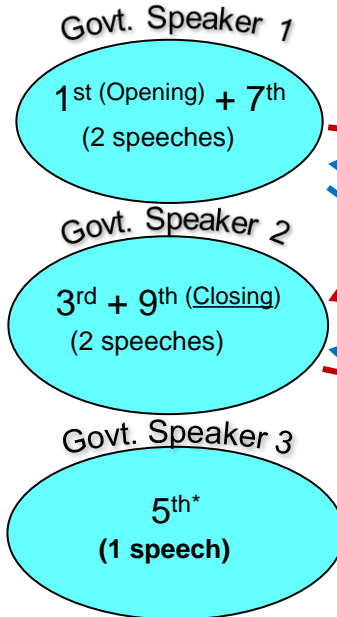
- The chairperson chairs the vote after the debate is over

Speech turns for a debate team 3 vs. 3: **Yellows** (6)

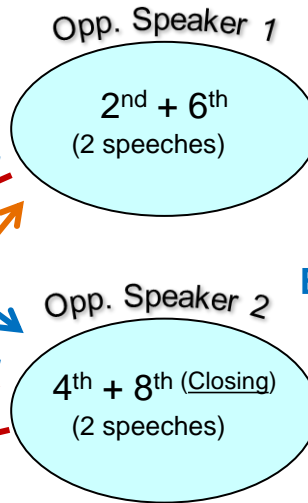


Speech turns for 3 vs 2: Blues (5*)

Red line: first round
Blue line: second round

For the **Blues**, the **3rd Gov. Speaker** will have only one speech and thus one chance to refute, but it'll be the **2nd Gov. Speaker**, who is the final speaker of the whole debate, and who summarises and states why they should win
