<b>Neutral reporting verbs</b>	
state mention note write remark report observe discuss describe outline explain investigate	briefly, in passing, insightfully, presciently, in depth, comprehensively, aptly  (note: in depth and comprehensively don't work with mention, note, remark or outline)
<b>Reporting results/assertions that you either align yourself with or take a neutral stance on</b>	<b>Possible modifiers</b>
demonstrate prove show provide evidence highlight identify	conclusively, convincingly, effectively
<b>Reporting a position (that you might not agree with)</b>	<b>Possible modifiers</b>
assert contend insist emphasize maintain declare stress claim argue conclude	strongly, falsely, unconvincingly, convincingly, disingenuously, stubbornly, adamantly, erroneously, ultimately
<b>Reporting mild/indirect/tacit assertions/tentative claims</b>	<b>Possible modifiers</b>
indicate imply suggest hypothesize propose	tentatively
<b>Demonstrating that one author disagrees with another (position)</b>	<b>Possible modifiers</b>
challenge contest question cast doubt on reject	strongly ('totally' for 'reject')
