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
## Assignment 1: Presentation Do's and Don'ts

**Step 1. (Alone , 5-10 min):** List as many **presenting do's and don'ts** (according to the column) as **you can think of** (don't stop to read what others have written).

**Step 2. (Alone , 5 min):** Read what others have written. If there are ideas/ notions that you **agree with then 'like'** them.

**Step 3. (With others , 15 min):** in a Zoom Break-out room, **discuss** what were **your top do's and don'ts**.

**Step 4.** Return to the main Zoom room for the wrap-up.

**Assignment 1: What are your presentation do's and don'ts?**

Step 1. For 5-10 min (Alone): List as many presenting do's and don'ts (according to the column) as you can think of (don't stop to read what others have written). To write, just click on the + sign in the relevant column and begin listing what comes to mind. NAME, e.g. AR. Step 2. Next 5 min (Alone): Read what others have written. If there are ideas/ notions that you agree with then 'like' them. Step 3. Last 15 min: in a Zoom Break-out room, discuss with the others in your room your top do's and don'ts worth adding to the Padlet. Step 4. Return to the main Zoom room for wrap-up.

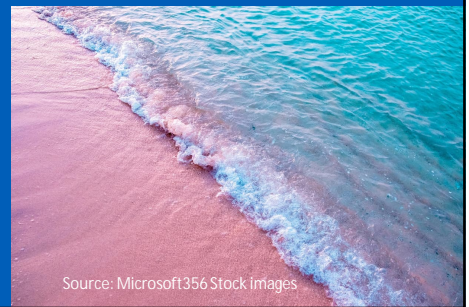
