Step 4. Return to the main Zoom room for the wrap-up.



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


You can book your first on-site practice date after A6 (completed during Week 2) has been accepted (during Week 3).

This course's 'Week' always begins on a Monday and often ends on a Sunday.


Pay attention to each assignment deadline! The deadlines can be set between *Tuesday to Sunday* of each course Week.
