Finland

- Republic, parliamentary democracy
- Parliament: 200 members in one chamber, elected every 4 years
- Cabinet: Multiparty coalition cabinet run by Prime Minister Petteri Orpo.
- Head of State: President of the Republic, elected every 6 years, two-term maximum. Currently Mr Alexander Stubb.





Finnish nature

- World's biggest archipelago
- Land of thousand lakes (more than 10 000 lakes)
- Rocky shores
- Europe's most forested country, 70% covered by trees, 8% protected





Weather

- Four seasons with great contrasts, in summer fairly warm (+30C/86F) and light, in winter cold (-30C/-22F) and dark
- In winter the daylight time is short, in December, only 6h in the South of the country
- in the summertime there is daylight around the clock

- the happiest country in the world (World Happiness Report 2023)
- the least corrupted country in the world (Transparency.org)
- a sauna loving country. There are about 3
 million saunas in Finland (for 5,5 million
 people). Sauna is a source of wellbeing and
 relaxation on an everyday basis.

- The Finnish good PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment by OECD) results have brought thousands of educationalists to Finland to learn about our system, schools and teachers since the beginning of the 2000s.


