



Providing and Utilizing Feedback (3 or 5 ECTS)

In this course the following questions are discussed: How to collect feedback more efficiently? How to utilize different kinds of feedback in developing your own course/teaching or module/degree program? How to provide feedback to students and colleagues at the university? Depending on your interest and needs you can choose whether you want to do a 3 or 5 cr version of the course.

Learning outcomes

After the course you:

- have widened your understanding of feedback.
- recognise different types and sources of feedback
- have some concrete means to collect and utilise feedback systematically
- you have written a process description of how feedback is collected and utilized in your department
- are able to provide feedback to different actors, e.g., student, and program leaders
- are able to write an action plan to develop instructional process based on feedback (5cr)
