



ARK-E5502 Puukaupunki-studio, Spring 2018

Puukaupunki is biannual joint studio run by the chairs of Landscape Architecture, Housing Design, Wood Architecture and Urban Design.

The subject of the studio in 2018 is the Turku Archipelago, especially the area of Iniö municipality.

The questions to be addressed in the studio concern the enlivening of the area on all scales - from the re-use of existing building stock to infill development and comprehensive change on the scale of the municipality. Affordable housing and the enabling of year round living are priorities in the studio.

Structure

Students work in groups on specific approaches to the studio theme - enlivening the Archipelago - and produce strategic approaches that are then elaborated/contrasted through individual projects.

The students will structure their own work and decide on whether to focus on issues concerning the larger scale of landscape and community, housing design or wood architecture - and get their credits accordingly (marked as a landscape, urban, housing or wood studio).
