<sup>10</sup>A *table computer* (also known as a tablet) is a portable electronic device that incorporates most features of a laptop computer. <sup>11</sup>Tablets share many similarities and differences with laptops and mobile phones. <sup>12</sup>Instead of a physical keyboard or mouse, a tablet is operated by touching the screen using a virtual keyboard and hand movements. <sup>13</sup>Some tablet models even include a digital pen for use in tasks requiring precision, such as handwriting or drawing. <sup>14</sup>Due to the lack of a physical keyboard and mouse, tablet computers are usually smaller and lighter than laptop computers.

<sup>15</sup>Typically, tablets are divided into three categories based on their size: *slates, mini tablets* and *phablets* [3]. <sup>16</sup>Slates are the largest of the tablets, with screen sizes ranging between 7 and 10 inches (diagonal). <sup>17</sup>The small tablets include mini tablets and phablets, which have diagonal dimensions of 6 and 5 inches, respectively. <sup>18</sup>Devices with smaller dimensions are normally classified as smartphones. <sup>19</sup>Similar to smartphones, tablets can be used to take pictures or record video and sound. <sup>20</sup>However, they cannot be used to make regular phone calls, as this function has not been implemented.
