


What sets us apart?

Humanism

- Anthropocentrism: humans have superlative status to nonhumans

For example:

- Reason (Aristotle)
- Soul (theism)
- Radical freedom (Sartre)
- Creativity (arts)



Chimeric beings coevolving in relation (and co-dependance) to one-another




















Exercise
