Course feedback system features

- Automatic feedback system: Questionnaires generated based on Oodi-information and published automatically.
- An easy-to-use tool for the teacher: Teacher can add course-related questions, publish the questionnaire earlier and get a preliminary report from the system
- Anonymous feedback channel for the student
- Comprehensive set of questions
- Automatic reporting



Questionnaire is published automatically.

Questionnaire is closed and reports are generated automatically.

Collecting the feedback

Processing the feedback

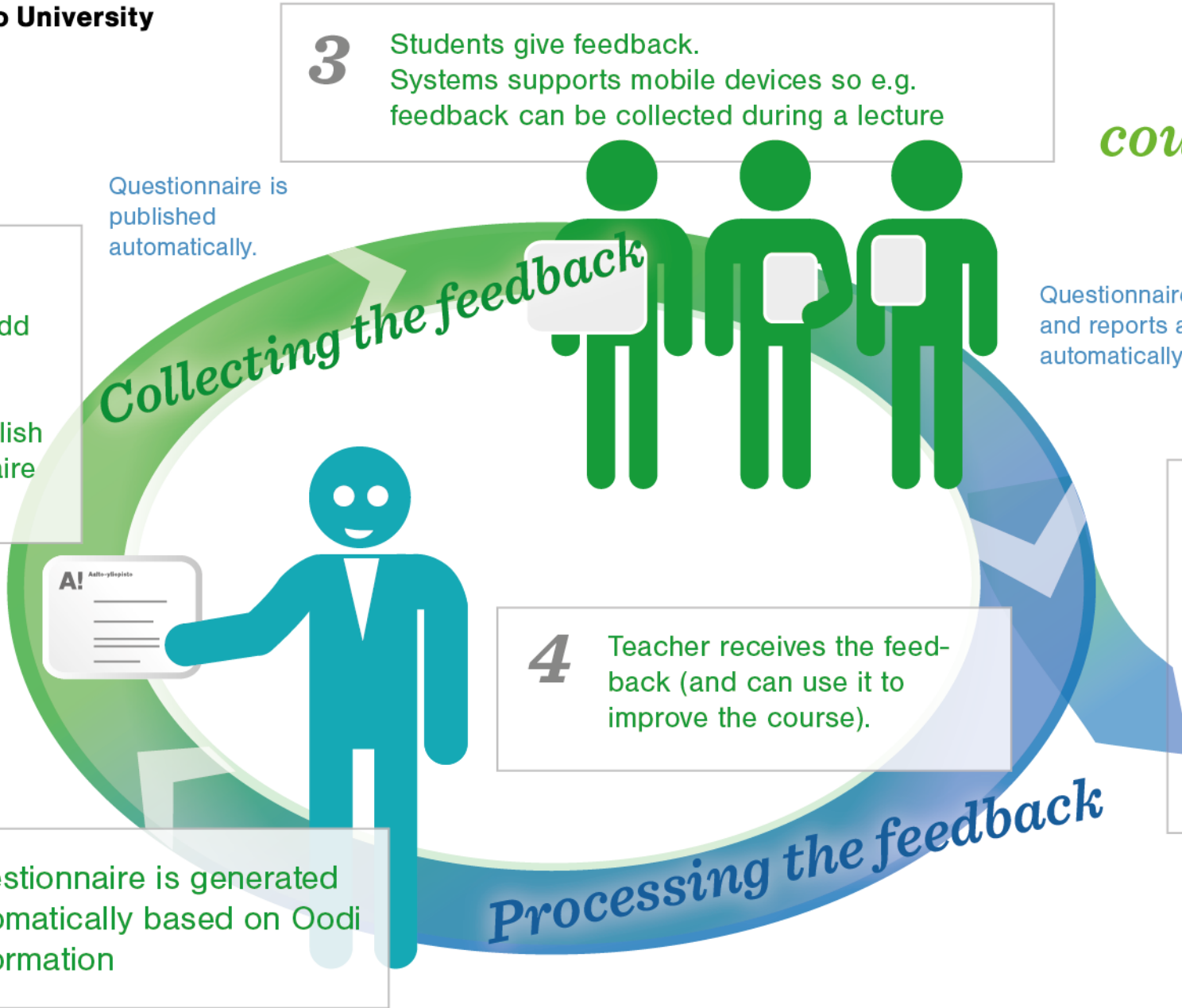
1 Questionnaire is generated automatically based on Oodi-information

2 Teacher can add course-related questions and choose to publish the questionnaire earlier.

3 Students give feedback. Systems supports mobile devices so e.g. feedback can be collected during a lecture

4 Teacher receives the feedback (and can use it to improve the course).

Aalto- and school questions (numeric data) is delivered to data storage. Reports to heads of schools and departments are generated automatically in January and June.



Development in 2015

With Webropol version 3.0

- Teacher is able to use several new question types
- Teacher is able to combine reports and analyze data with all Webropol tools.
- User interface is renewed

Reporting is improving: Custom reports with can be automatized (for example program report)
