




# **Setting up Arabic version of Adobe Indesign**



**Go to your  
Creative Cloud**




**Click on Preferences**



**In Preference press  
Apps**

**Choose the  
Default Install language  
to support Arabic**




**When you go to the homepage of the Creative Cloud you will notice **Install** next to already downloaded apps on your computer.**

When you have existing CC applications installed, and then you switch to a different language, its normal to see «Install» button beside all applications.


Don't panic!  
This is a feature. When you switch the language, it is allowing you now to install yet another copy with Arabic support.

**After you installed go to Indesign.**


**Inside Indesign activate the Paragraph window.**



**Reminders about the Paragraph window :**  
This justifies the text to the right. Work with the Arabic direction

This is the Right-to-Left Paragraph direction  
*Makes sure the fullstops, commas are at the right place.*

This Option helps if you want to have fully justified text

## **CheckList:**

- Always make sure you choose a font that supports Arabic. Those can be found in Adobe typekit, fontstand, and Google.
- Make sure the Arabic glyphs are connected!
- Make sure the paragraph is Right-to-Left
- Justification can be centererd, right justified, fully justified, fully justified center, fully justified right
- Have fun!
