A GOOD PODCAST (IS A BIT BAD TOO)

- Episodic downloadable audio files anytime&anywhere.
- You can do it!
- Any topic counts!
 From blow jobs to interviewing interviewers abt interviewing!
- Personality stands out.
- Quality stands out, technical and content quality.
- Art, entertainment or business?
- It's intimate and there is loyalty...and money.

- Basic Structure should sustain thru all episodes.
- What's the theme/genre of yr podcast?
- Do you want to include distinct segments within the show? If so, what kind?
- Do you want to improvise, chat with guests, or read from a script?
- How often you will release episodes, and how long do you want them to be?

Simple example of episode structure



Opening

May include sound effects, a tag line, short song or jingle.

Be creative!

Introduction

Welcome listeners to the podcast.
Introduce host(s) and guests.
Introduce topic(s).
May also give overview of how the podcast will be sequenced and may also include (background) sounds.

Podcast Content and Interview

Overview of the central issue/question/controversy and why it is important. Use yr script if needed.

Outro/Summary

Conclusion strategies: call to action, prediction, etc. Thank listeners for listening. Closing music, sounds etc.

- Script keeps you focused, gives clarity to yr content
- Good script is "invisible", conversational like.
- Write for the ear. Simple sentences with rhythm, ruleofthumb "long-short-long-short"
- Test yr text read it out loud!
- Use yr personality, be intimate.

- First segment needs to be most appealing
- Segments keeps listener interested: main content, intro/outro, jingles, music, transitions, (sponsor) messages, recap, review, topical info, Q&A, boost yr next episode... etc.
- Use sparingly!
