Individual Oral Exam via Zoom incl. Camera

- 1) 7-8 min topics by S. Bankar (25% of grade)
- 2) 7-8 min topics by S. Scheller (25% of grade)

Procedure:

- Zoom link with waiting room (https://aalto.zoom.us/j/65571918781)
- Be there 2 min (latest 60 seconds) before; Show your ID in the beginning
- You can choose the topic of the beginning (3-4 min) of the first part

Some general points:

- The goal is a fair assessment of the learning outcomes
- Usual start: "Please explain ... " or "Why is ..." or "Tell me about ..."
- After a short discussion, we may share screen, show a diagram etc. and you need to explain. Or you may need to draw on paper and show to camera
- We are evaluating <u>how deeply you have achieved the learning outcomes</u>. It is not about the number of answers that were correct/incorrect
- We are not correcting or providing feedback during the exam
- If there are any issues, the exam will be aborted (e.g. no camera etc.)
 - → make sure that everything works well, and be one time

Administrative Aspects

- Grading scheme: All parts will give points from 0-100:
- >50pt = 1; >60pt = 2; >70pt = 3; >80pt = 4; >90pt = 5.
- For additional exercises: "100%" means 5 points, 80% means 4 points etc.
