WHAT DOES IT MEAN 'TO LEAD'?

- Role model
- Set an example
- Qualifiers of leadership: experience, brave, power
- Do we always need a leader? Depends on group size?
- Need leadership -> taking responsibility of any kind
- Acting in a way thinking about the consequences
- Vision for the future, ideas that they want to deploy in the future, make possible
- Leaving the world in a better place than it was
- Role of a leader to create psychological safety -> what would mean for oneself
- Safe atmosphere, good atmosphere
- Good leader motivates others to do things, sets boundaries
- Boundaries not only for strategy but also creativity
- Empathy, empathically understand what the employees want to do, listen closely
- Equal treatment, no favoritism
