What is Co-Creation?


Co-creation is a **creative process** that taps into the **collective potential of groups** to generate **insights and innovation**.

A network of knowledge bridges between team members of a novice team.






Process for a Co-Creation Journey

- Identify your **objectives** and **plan** the project
- 1) Define Project Stakeholders
- 2) Identify gaps in knowledge & skills
- 3) Assemble and engage your co-creation team
- Teach and train **co-creation skills** of your team
- 5) **Share knowledge** within your team
- 6) Produce **new knowledge** with your team
- 7) Use collective intelligence to co-create
- 8) Record & document results for further use
- 9) Come back for piloting & testing




