What happens with the reality in cinema, and does the limit separating objective truth from the author's vision exists?

SHORT BIOGRAPHY.

Audrius Stonys is a Lithuanian film director and producer as well as Professor in the Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theatre. Audrius has been awarded the Lithuanian National Culture and Art Award. His films got numerous international film awards, amongst them the Audience award in Vision du Réel, Nyon, Grand Prix in Split, prizes in Bornholm, Florence, Gyor, Neu Brandenburg, Oberhausen, Riga, Shanghai, Bilbao and San Francisco. In 1992 the documentary film "Earth of the Blind" was recognized by European Film Academy as the Best European Documentary Film of the Year. Audrius acted as 2004-2005 Documentary teacher in European Film College, Denmark. He has imparted lectures and master classes in Kolkata, Sao Paulo, Seoul, Tokyo, Berkeley, Stanford, Belgrade, Barcelona, San Francisco, Carpi Modena, Paris and Amsterdam. Film presentations in Switzerland, France, Israel, Czech Republic, Germany, USA, Belgium, Spain, Turkey, Colombia, Uruguay, Italy.
