# Top tips for exceptional times

- 1. Install VPN on your home devices to get access to Aalto's network wherever you are (<a href="https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/establishing-a-remote-connection-vpn-to-an-aalto-network">https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/establishing-a-remote-connection-vpn-to-an-aalto-network</a>)
- 2. Install free Office on your devices (<a href="https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/microsoft-office-package-installation-on-students-and-employees-own-devices">https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/microsoft-office-package-installation-on-students-and-employees-own-devices</a>)
- 3. Familiarize yourself with the online meeting tools (<a href="https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/online-meeting-tools-teams-and-zoom">https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/online-meeting-tools-teams-and-zoom</a>)

# **Campus Wifi**

- 3 networks: Aalto Open, Aalto and Eduroam
- Aalto Open: Unsecured network!
  - No authentication, just connect and browse, but traffic is <u>not</u> encrypted!
  - NAT in use
- Aalto network
  - Safe and encrypted
- Eduroam: pan-european network of wifi networks, secure
  - You can use any eduroam network in Europe, in Finland eg. Helsinki University
  - Traffic encrypted
  - Needs configuration and Thawte root certificate, check Aalto Inside for instructions
  - https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/installation-instructions-for-eduroam
  - Most services allowed, SMTP blocked
- Terms of Use for wireless network
- For printing, use MobilePrint
- Lots of Access Points at the campus, notify IT Services if there is lack of coverage



#### Computer classrooms

- Check campus opening policy at <u>www.aalto.fi</u>
- Access control in use in many buildings, see <a href="https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/access-control-with-hsl-card">https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/access-control-with-hsl-card</a>
- In many buildings in Otaniemi
  - Maarintalo, open 24/7 (excl. Midsummer and Christmas)
    - A lot of workstations (Win / Linux) in classrooms and group work areas
    - Student card required!
  - Also other 24/7 classrooms with separate access cards
- Windows 10, Linux and Mac classrooms
- Different applications depending on the classroom
- All workstations have basic software (Windows: MS Office, Firefox, etc.)

- Scanners in Maari lobby, Kandi building hub and Kandi building 3rd floor printing point
- Some departments' classrooms
- Student hubs and group work spaces



#### **Email**

- Usually <u>firstname.lastname@aalto.fi</u> (sometimes middle initial)
- Microsoft Exchange based email
  - https://mail.aalto.fi
    with any browser anywhere
  - You can use Microsoft Outlook, Mozilla Thunderbird, iPhone, Android, etc.
    (IMAP)
  - Instructions to configure at aalto.fi/it
  - Official IT reminders (password expiring etc.) to Aalto address, forwarding possible for students
- Uses same password as other services
- Spam filtering, Junk e-mail folder
- Will be erased after you leave Aalto University



#### **O365**

- "Good old office" (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.) with secure cloud services (One Drive)
- Also for your own device at home!
- Works with your Aalto account
- File sharing and teamwork


#### **VDI**

- Virtual Desktop Infrastructure
- You can access an Aalto virtual workstation from your own device from anywhere
- Aalto Windows 10 and Aalto Linux

  - VMWare client or HTML access

- Accessible also via SFTP on our Linux servers (kosh.org.aalto.fi and lyta.aalto.fi) and VDI
- Remember! Your files from network drive will be erased when you graduate.
- Use also a memory stick or USB hard disk to backup all your important files. Computer can crash, network does not always work, etc. All very important files should be saved to 3 places.

  - Antivirus software, SSH Tectia Client, Matlab, Comsol, SPSS, etc...
  - May only be used while studying at Aalto!
  - Accessible from home as well
- Microsoft products for Aalto students
  - Check Aalto fi for information
  - Free Office 365 with Student Advantage (including 5 TB OneDrive)

  - OnTheHub may have discounted Microsoft software, (Microsoft's service)

- Control who can edit, read, administrate

- students Start writing your own blog
- Follow other blogs and comment



# **User Account and password**

- Activate your account e.g. with banking credentials <a href="https://password.aalto.fi/">https://password.aalto.fi/</a>
- One Aalto password for all your needs (email, workstations, wifi, ...)
- Password policy
  - Minimum 12 characters
  - Password maximum lifetime 730 days
  - Password minimum lifetime 24 hours
  - Complexity: must contain both uppercase and lowercase letters, as well as numbers
  - Åäö should not be used
  - Math marks do not work on all servers, as also å,ä,ö
  - You can use the same password only once

### **Password Security**

- Never tell anyone your password
  - IT Services personnel will never want or need your password
  - Your account is personal, not for sharing
- Try to remember
- If you have to write it down, hide it and keep it away from your username
- Phishing
  - If you get an email from anywhere asking for your password, do not reply
  - Instructions on reporting phishing attempts on aalto.fi (<a href="https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/how-to-report-a-malicious-or-suspicious-email">https://www.aalto.fi/en/services/how-to-report-a-malicious-or-suspicious-email</a>)
- If you forget: password.aalto.fi (with banking credentials, mobile certificate or HST card) or come to IT Service Desk with your ID. Must be done in person.
- Change all your passwords regularly and also when you suspect it's no longer secret

# **Account Security**

- Do not use the same password in other services!
- Email inherently suspicious: do <u>not</u> trust the Sender field or attachments
- Check your URL when entering passwords
- Always log out from your workstation when stepping out
  - Or lock if you are returning soon
- Take care of the security of your own PC as well
- USB memory sticks
  - Easy to lose or break
  - Viruses



# **Account Security (cont'd)**

- Respect other users' privacy
  - Other people's email, files, passwords, sessions
  - Personal data (e.g. email addresses, student numbers) not to be distributed
  - Confidential research/business data
- You are responsible for the activity on your account
- Commercial, political, sectarian activity forbidden per Usage Policy
  - Exception: student union activity
- We back-up most of the data, but you have the ultimate responsibility
- Second, private email address convenient
  - You will lose your university address upon leaving/graduation
  - Secondary email address easier to throw away
- Use common sense
