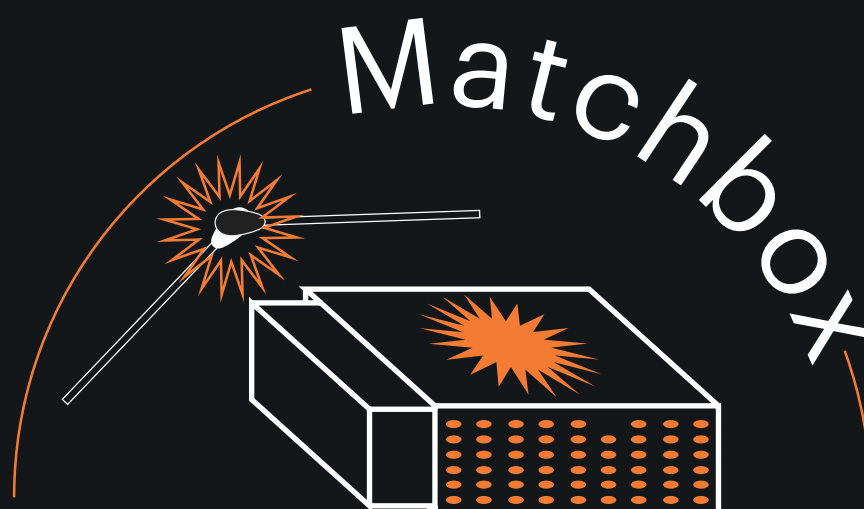

- Raise your hand when you wish to speak (unless you are a judge or teacher)

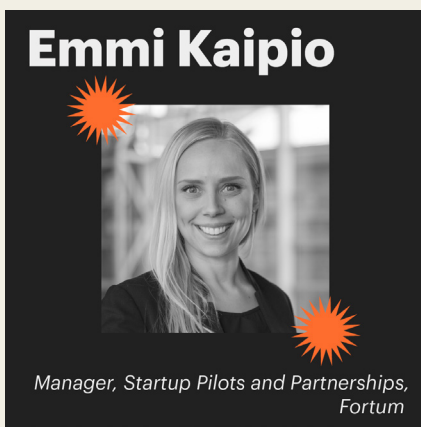

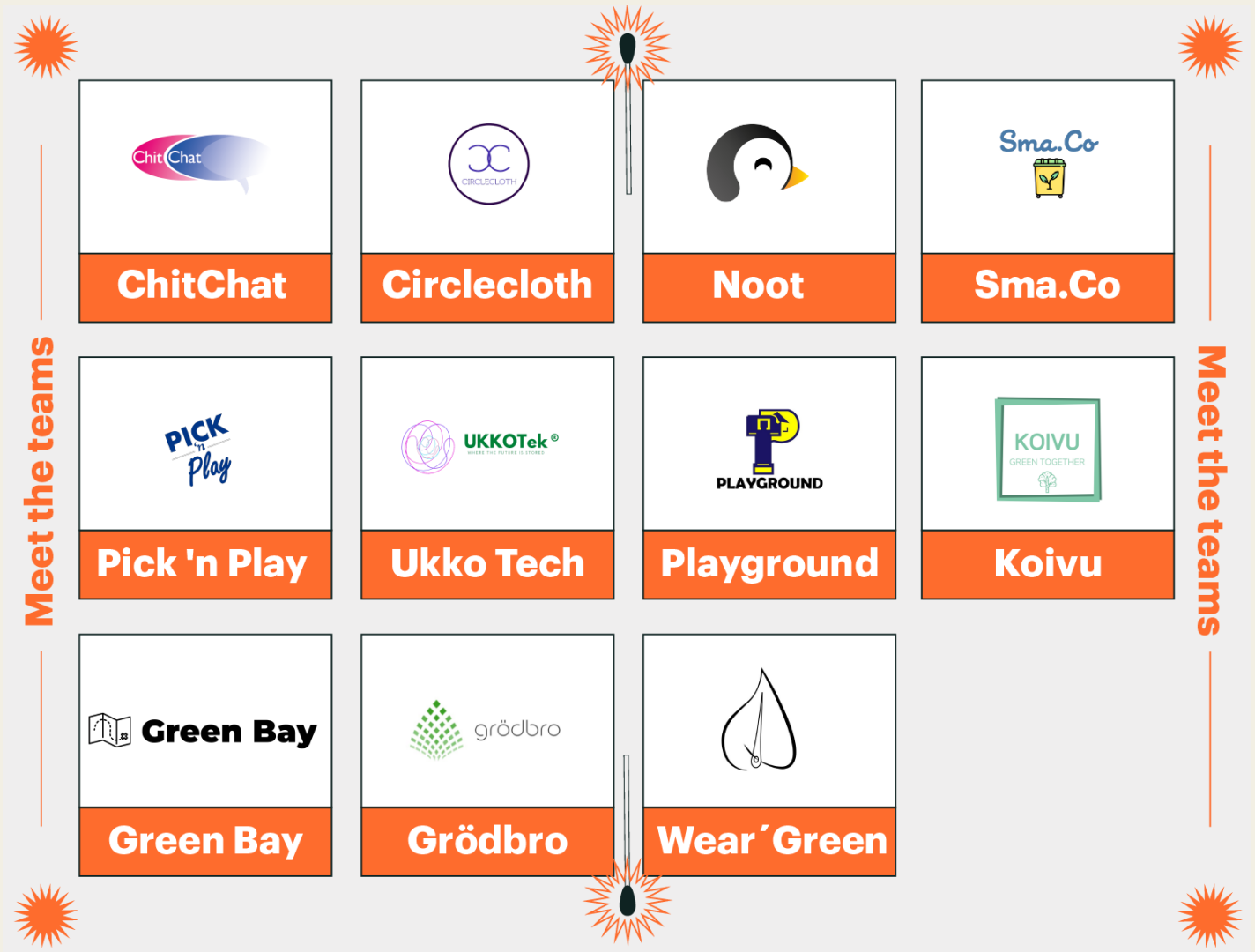

Networking on Airmeet –

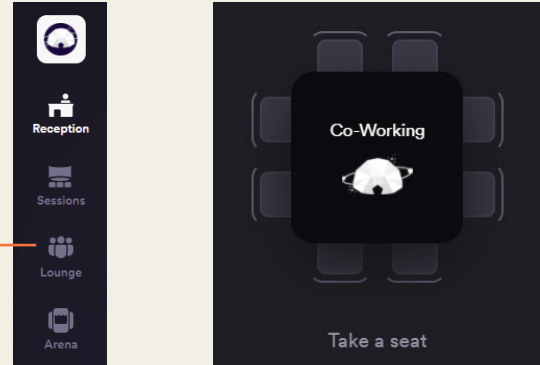
Join our virtual social lounge (in partnering with Startup Space Helsinki) is available on Airmeet for your inspiring conversation! Here is how you get there:
