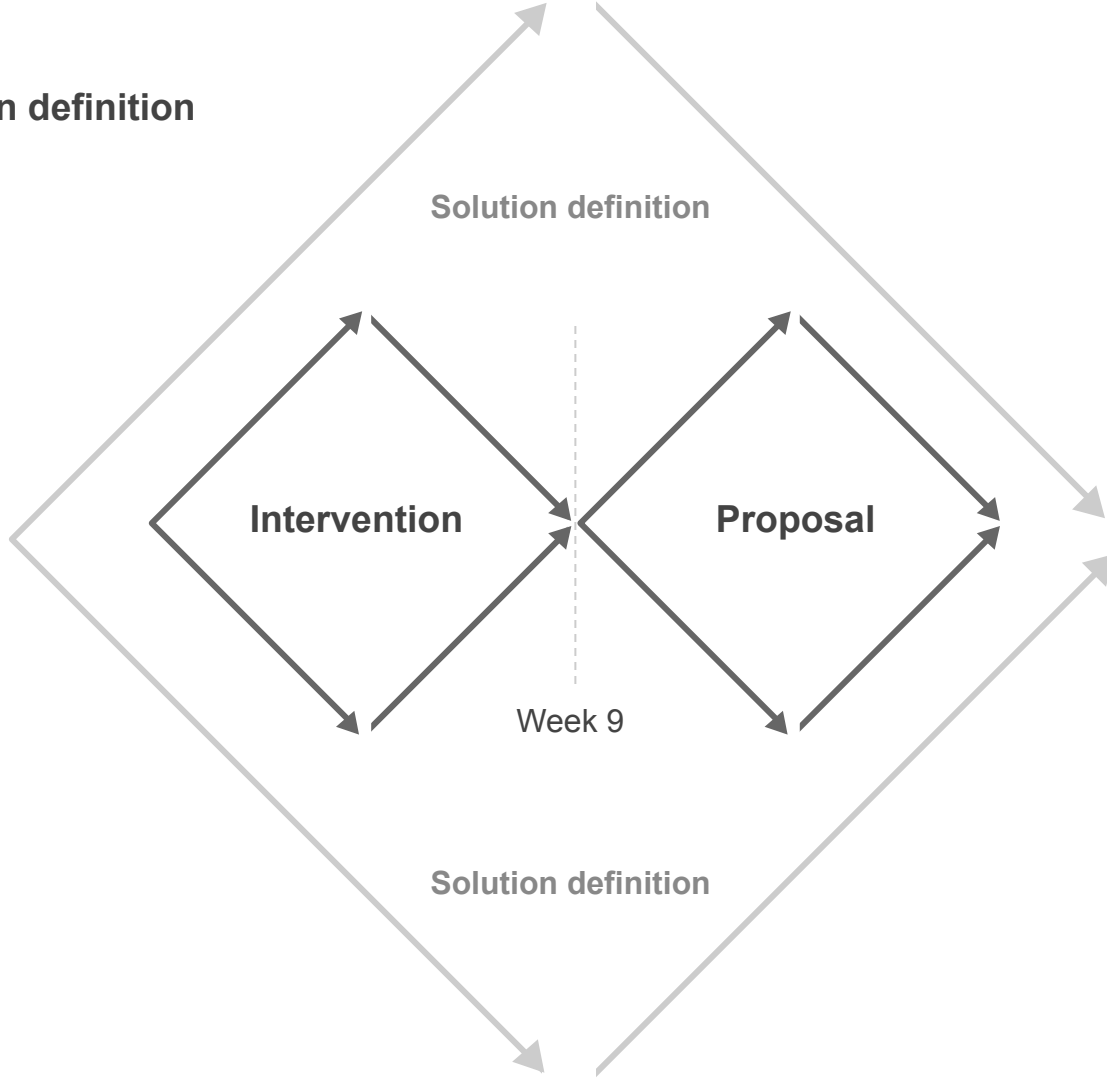

# Period V Solution definition



## Monday 3rd May: Ideation with peers!

### In your projects:

- Behaviour/Change: Identify exactly what behaviour(s) is to be influenced or what needs to change
- Insight: Add contextual information that add some insight about this behaviour.
