Communication skills

- perception & interpretation

 ${\rightarrow}{\rightarrow}$ defining others? leap of faith

- planning your actions based on your objectives
- comm. accommodation (H. Giles: CAT)
- structure, clarity, argumentation
- quantity, quality, relevance, manner (H.P. Grice: maxims of conversation)
- competence: knowledge, skills, attitudes
