
## 5.1-3 Logical progression: Cohesion test



## **Cohesion test: Prepare**

## Instructions: Prepare a scrambled paragraph for a cohesion test

- 1. Copy and paste one paragraph of your own writing in a new document
- 2. Divide the paragraph up sentence by sentence (= separate all sentences)
- 3. However, keep the first sentence in place and scramble the other sentences (so that they aren't in the correct order)



## **Cohesion test: Peer work**

- 1. Exchange paragraphs via Forum 5.1-3 Cohesion: Peer exchange
- 2. Task: Try to re-construct your peer's paragraph
  - Note: The topic and the controlling idea in the topic sentence
  - Hint: Look for lexical clues in the sentences, such as
    - Repeated words, words from the same family, or synonyms
    - General words that refer to something specific mentioned elsewhere (e.g. the place, the facility, this research)
    - Words from the same thematic field (e.g. text, readers, written)
    - Thematic progression: constant, linear, split
    - Relationships between sentences (e.g. cause-effect, contrast, addition, example)
