

Why this course?




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
Academic skills are the skills that you will need in order to take full advantage of all the knowledge that is at your disposal during your university studies.

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Expertice and skills



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- Future working life skills!
- Requirements in master-level studies differ from bachelor's studies – you are required more self-leadership
- Remote study mode highlights the need for good study skills and techniques



The purpose of this course is to learn and practice new skills or enhance such existing skills that will benefit both your studies and your career in the future of work.

 The course has been planned in co-operation with student psychologists, Aalto pedagogical experts, ELEC lecturers and the ELEC learning services.

Self-assessment

First assignment

- you assess which study skills you need to improve or develop during the course
- goal is to choose the optional contents that benefit you the most
- deadline 24.9.2021

Second assignment

- you evaluate how your goals have realized during the course
- deadline 25.2.2022



Mentoring

Academic advising, ie. mentoring is organized as a part of this course.

- You will be assigned a professor or other academic faculty member of your major as your mentor sign up to a group by 20.9.2021.
- You will have two individual meetings, one in Autumn and one in Spring.
- Assignments in study and career planning as well as in the thesis process start -sections will be discussed with the mentor.
- You will receive information on your mentor and meeting arrangements after 20.9.



Study and career planning – period I

- The goal of this part is a well-planned, justified and goaloriented personal study plan (HOPS).
- This part consists of 4 items during period I:
 - Career planning assignment (choose 1 out of 3 options by 24.9.), DL 4 Oct
 - 2. Study-planning assignment, DL 4 Oct
 - 3. Mentor meeting and meeting report, DL in December
 - 4. Submission of official study plan (HOPS), DL 17 December



Thesis process start – period III

- The goal of this part is to provide you with basic information about master's thesis and planning tools for a smooth thesis work during the second year of your master's studies.
- This part consists of four parts that are completed during III-IV periods
 - 1. Thesis info lecture in January 2022
 - 2. Thesis review assignment
 - 3. Thesis brainstorming assignment
 - 4. Mentor meeting and meeting report



Choose three assignments, periods I-II

- Seven optional assignments choose three (descriptions are available in MyCourses under "Descriptions"):
 - 1. Essay assignment, optional material
 - 2. Ethics in Technology
 - 3. Getting things done online workshop
 - 4. Learning skills online workshop
 - 5. Superstudent
 - 6. Time management
 - 7. Academic writing assignment
- The themes are learning as a skill that can be developed, developing ethical problems solving, time management and academic writing skills, and coping with procrastination.
- Some parts have limited attendence it is mentioned in the description.



Choose three assignments

- Choose the optional assignments that offer you the most learning experience. Challenge yourself - do not select the topics that you are already comfortable with!
- Read the descriptions carefully.
- Take advantage of the findings you have made in the self-assessment
- Schedule wisely if your period I is full, select period II versions instead.
- Ask if you need more information.
- Choose three optional assignments by Friday 24.9. in MyCourses page.
- You can start doing the period I assignments immediately (depending on their schedule)
