(limited!) hybrid teaching and students in classrooms

Unfortunately, Corona restrictions are tightening again. In order to be able to act responsibly and keep everybody as safe as possible, we are following closely what is happening. As per the Metropolitan Area coronavirus coordination group, the use of masks is again recommended in all spaces where other people are present. Classroom use has not yet been limited, though, so all students are still welcome to attend Friday's sessions on location. Lecture hall U270 U8 (on the other side of Rakentajanaukio, see map below) has a capacity of 115 people -- to optimise the use of this space in terms of safety, we suggest that you seat yourself so that the distance between groups is maximised. For those unable to attend on location, the sessions will be streamed through Zoom as before. In case of in-session group work, remote students will have to make their own arrangements to communicate with their group members.
