

The spectrum of online learning

HYBRID LEARNING

Online and face-to-face instruction are integrated.

Combines internet-based activities and some amount of time in a traditional classroom.

BLENDED LEARNING

Learning occurs in a traditional classroom, but technology is essential part in facilitating activities, delivering content and assessing students.

ONLINE LEARNING

Almost all instruction, interaction and activities take place online.


FACE-TO-FACE

Learning occurs in a traditional classroom 100 % of the time. Using technology in enhancing learning is optional but not required.

In Hybrid Flex students could choose between


- Face-to-face class sessions inperson

Sense of togetherness


- Audio quality is essential (understanding and spatiality)

Smartphone

- Running Zoom
- Joined to the Zoom session as a participant
- Video and microphone on
- Online participants can see via this device
- Connected wirelessly to the speakerphone
- Mounted on light tripod

Speakerphone

- Speaker/Microphone
- Carried around to close proximity of the speaking person onsite
- Online participants can speak/hear via this device
- Connected wirelessly to the smartphone

A media rich repository of guides, tutorials and case examples online for individual study purposes.


Formal training and consultation well in advance the final planning and execution of the course for coaching and practicing.











Basic hybrid classroom setup at Aalto










