AYY for a new student



Who decides what AYY does?

representative council

Aalto students vote for **45 student representatives**, 2 years highest decision-making body, strategy and budget

employees



board

~ **40**, e.g. specialists, support & know-how

The representative council chooses **10 students**, I year: executes the strategy

volunteers

associations

200 associations, that make Aalto what it is

150-200 volunteers e.g. in committees and sections



Influencing & advocacy

- On local and national levels
- Educational politics: e.g. quality of teaching and Aalto's strategy renewal process
- Social politics: e.g. FSHS, student income
- International affairs: e.g. internationalization in Finland, immigration issues and residence permits



Community

- 14 000 members
- IOO+ fields of expertise and almost IOO nationalities represented
- About 200 associations
 - In addition to subject associations, there are also sports, music and culture clubs
- Hundreds of volunteers in different sections and committees



Services

- Student card
 - Kela meal subsidy
 - Various student benefits throughout Finland, e.g. VR
- Housing
 - About 2600 apartments
- Health and well-being
 - FSHS services (excluding exchange students)
