

Annotated Bibliography

- ♦ Revise your 5 selections based on the feedback
- ♦ Read them with notes. Notes for each article include:
 1. Provide the full bibliographic citation [in the APA citation style ([link](#))]
 2. Indicate the background of the author(s) [which academic field(s) they are from]
 3. Indicate the content or scope of the text [max 1 paragraph]
 4. Outline the main argument [max 1 paragraph]
 5. Indicate the intended audience [max 1 paragraph]
 6. Identify the research methods if applicable [max 1 paragraph]
 7. Identify any conclusions made by the author(s) [max 1 paragraph]
 8. Explain its connection to your research topic [why you chose it, and how it helps you to answer your research question(s)]

** You may use visualization(s) to explain above points.*

Citation Style



- ♦ How to communicate in academia while acknowledging others properly
- ♦ Different academic tradition follows different style
