Assignment: Team Presentation

At the end of the course, you will introduce your solution/s to the rest of the class. Similar to the writing process, we will also follow a process approach to the final presentations.

Your final presentation should be 15-20 minutes long and each member of your team needs to speak for at least 3 minutes. Your presentation needs to include an introduction, a body and a conclusion. Since you are presenting as a team, pay special attention to smooth transitions between speakers.

Make sure that in the presentation you introduce

- 1. the current situation
- 2. the problem you've identified in the scenario
- 3. your solution/s to the problem including all aspects of expertise (design, technology, business) in your group
- 4. recommendation based on the evaluation of your solution

After the presentation, there will be 10-15 minutes for questions and discussion (being an opponent).
