 - Greetings, numbers, basic information, introducing yourself
 - Family
 - Talking about your day
 - Food
 - + Finnish 2 topics
 - Weather
 - Travel
 - Health and wellbeing
 - Celebrations
- be able to function in **routine situations** and make common enquiries.
- understand and be able to produce **short written messages** about situations in your day of working or studying
- be able to find the **main information you need from short texts** on course themes
- know some of the main features of Finnish everyday life and work

- Oral examination
 - this is a 15 minute one on one conversation with Mari
 - dates and times coming up soon
 - 25 % of your grade
- Let me know in advance about any accommodations you need for the exams and the course work
