
Turnitin via MyCourses

during doctoral studies

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Turnitin – a common tool for students and their supervisor (or advisor)

Student uses the feedback to modify and continue writing until the next submission



Supervisor can give feedback in the same view when reading the draft and its similarity report Student submits a thesis or publication draft to their supervisor



Both see
Turnitin's
automatically
generated
similarity report
on the draft

- supports learning of scientific writing and
- helps to prevent unintentional or intentional plagiarism

Turnitin usage is at its best when used for drafts as a natural part of the advising/supervising process (as a *formative tool*).



How to use Turnitin in MyCourses?

As a doctoral student you can submit drafts of your publications and dissertation in your supervisor's (or advisor's) personal workspace in MyCourses.

Does your supervisor (advisor) have their own workspace in MyCourses.aalto.fi?



type their name in the MyCourses search



Search result: a title like "Thesis supervision [Person's Name] [year(s)]" You can use the workspace (see the next slide)

No result: your supervisor should order one.
Or perhaps you can order one on their behalf?
Mention if you do so in the order form:
MyCourses.aalto.fi > Service links (on the orange tab) > Workspace for thesis supervision




Ready-made personal workspace in MyCourses for a supervisor or advisor and their students

As a student:

- follow the instructions on the home page in order to enrol in the workspace and
- choose your thesis level
- now you can submit in a Turnitin activity (Submissions page)





Submissions in the MyCourses inbox > Handling in Turnitin Feedback Studio

Student's view in the MyCourses inbox after a file is submitted:



When the submission is opened, Turnitin Feedback Studio opens in a new tab.

Turnitin for advisors and course teachers

Advising a master's thesis?

Request a personal workspace for yourself.

(See how on slide 3)

Advising a bachelor's thesis?

- Does the thesis seminar workspace have a Turnitin assignment?
 Student uses this
- Request a personal workspace for yourself; students can use this

Teaching a course where course work includes essays and reports?

Add a Turnitin activity to help support integrity and good scientific writing

Turn editing on > Add an activity or resource > tap Turnitin assignment and read Turnitin instructions on the right before you Add the activity



Turnitin has a tool to identify Al-generated text visible to instructors only
