Aim of the course

- The aim of the course is to get acquainted with what research is.
- First year students get an **overview** of artistic research and practice-led research. Use it to get acquainted to what research is.
- Second year students can use the materials, assignments and lectures for the development of their ongoing research.

Assignments

- You can use the assignments as exercises towards a **fictional project** that interests you, **or** an actual thesis draft, as you prefer.
- The final draft is a tool to help you summarise what you could do.
- The learning diary is your space to **reflect** and **keep track** of what is useful and makes sense for you.

Readings

- During these seven weeks you are asked to choose, read and do the literature review of two readings.
- First year students can choose the ones that interest you right now.
- Second year students can use the ones you are already using in your research.

What we cannot change:

- The **poster** requirement is mandatory
- ViCCA and VCD together

...but we will ask you to fill in a questionnaire during the last class to present these issues for planning the next course. I find it somewhat frustrating that the lecturers continuously expect us to go back to their slides.
