



## When can I apply?

Bachelor students:

- min. 30 ECTS
- present one term at Aalto
- Min. GPA 2,00 (can vary, always check)


Everyone:

# For those paying tuition fee (bachelor level)

If the exchange takes place in the 3rd spring semester (i.e. the last semester of the degree's target period)

- $\rightarrow$  a high risk that the exchange studies will not be registered within the frames of the last semester.
- → the student can be granted a grant for an extra semester (as long as all the criteria are met), so that the exchange courses can be completed and they can be registered.
- ightarrow However, using the grant for an extra semester automatically means that the student no longer meets the criteria for a master's grant.
