Major or Programme organises. Public event where complete but unpolished theses are presented & discussed. Feedback for the completion. Supervisor gives permission to hand-in thesis. Supervisor decides examiners. At least two weeks for making final adjustments, e.g. layout, concluding texts, fixing issues. Upload finished text to the plagiarism detection system TurnItIn. Send the report to the supervisor. Supervisor checks academic integrity and helps with issues. As a PDF to the eAge-system. The date of submission is also the graduation date if the thesis is approved.

PDF can be corrected and reuploaded until the Department deadline. If a serious mistake surfaces after the deadline, the student can ask for termination of the examination. Production/fieldwork/primary research. Initial analysis for results and conclusions. Editing methodology and research questions. Supervisor gives feedback to Part 2.







Thesis Plan Proposal: IN GENERAL

- 3-6 pages
- Sharp, to the point
- Clear, well-structured
- Grounded, reasoned, framed, contextualised
- On a topic worth investing time
- On a topic relevant to the field of design
- With framing that makes the plan doable

Thesis Plan Proposal: IDENTIFIERS

- Working title
- Language of the thesis (EN, FI or SV)
- Your name and study major or programme
- Supervisor (if known)
- Advisor(s) (if known)

Thesis Plan Proposal: SUBSTANCE Typically, the longest part of the proposal

- Motivations and justifications for the topic
- Outline of previous research (= summary of literature)
- Academic and artistic research goals
- Outline of production (if any)
- Methodological choices. How are goals achieved?


