

 - 180 students






Normative duration of BSc degree

You have been admitted to study both BSc. And MSc. degree at the School of Business. A student admitted to study for the Bachelor's and Master of Science degree has the right to complete the degree in a time exceeding the normative duration (3 years for BSc. degree and 2 years for MSc. degree) of studies by a maximum of two years. So altogether your study right has been granted to you for 7 years.

Remember to enroll as attending/nonattending for each semester!

• You can register as non-attending for max. 2 semesters (1 year) and it does not affect your study time.

Bachelor's degree 180 cr = 3 years of full time studies BSc. graduation in June 2026



Bachelor's degree structure

- Three years with 60 ECTS / academic year = 180 ECTS credits
- Bachelor of Science (Economics and Business Administration)



- Requirements for attendance are in general mentioned in the course description
- All details related to the courses (teaching arrangements, exam arrangements, assignment DLs etc.) are available in MyCourses.
- Course syllabus is published 3 weeks before the course begins in MyCourses

Registering for courses and exams

- Registration for all courses and exams in SISU (sisu.aalto.fi).
- Course registration opens 28 days before the teaching period begins.
- Course registrations ends:
 - <u>7 days before</u> the teaching period begins, for courses with limited number of participants, or
 - <u>7 days after</u> the course has started, for courses with no limited number of participants.
- Cancellation possible in SISU only when the registration is open. After the registration has closed, you can discontinue your participation.
- Note! Students must register separately for re-exams in SISU.

Exam registration

Course exam (KT = kurssitentti)

When you register for a course, you are automatically registered for the course examination, which is held at the end of the course during the examination week.

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you do not need to register for the first sitting of the course examination (abbreviated KT) if you have registered for the course.

- Students must register separately for all other examinations (for example reexaminations and book examinations). Registration for these exams begin on Sisu two months before and end 7 days before the date of the exam.


