

Group Assignment: The Once and Future Kings of Personal Computing and Communication





Overall Description

In this assignment you are tasked with analyzing three (3) major disruptions in Digital Business (+ 4th viewpoint on future):

- How <u>Microsoft</u> gained a dominant position in <u>personal computers</u> (and <u>Apple</u> failed)?
- How <u>Nokia</u> gained a dominant position in <u>mobile phones</u> (and <u>Microsoft</u> and others failed)?

- 3. How <u>Google</u> and <u>Apple</u> gained a dominant position in <u>smartphones</u> (and <u>Nokia</u> and <u>Microsoft</u> failed)?
- 4. And last, to provide your own analysis for the best bet of what is the current or upcoming technological life cycle that a competitor could ride to replace the current kings of personal computing. What next?

Group Assignment: Case timelines (DL 21.11)

This is an intermediate phase submission intended to help you in analysing the development of the case firms. Not to be graded, but compulsory for the groups.

- <u>Collect information</u> on the <u>development of the case firms</u> and <u>the relevant technologies</u>, <u>markets, businesses, and industries</u> from the duration of the three disruptions described in the group assignment.
- <u>Create a timeline or timelines of the events</u> in a <u>format of your choice</u>. The timeline(s) can be visual, a table, text or whatever combination you prefer.
- The goal of the timeline(s) is to help you in writing the final report. You should <u>create such timelines that help you compare case firm actions and relative success, the technological lifecycles and discontinuities involved</u>. In other words, the timeline(s) should map development of both the relevant technologies and business success of relevant firms.

Tip: You could include the (improved) timelines in your final report in appendices or otherwise, if you see it fit.

Individual Assignment DL 18.12

- 1. Explain the phases how innovations are deployed in industries and how competition evolves in different phases? What types of innovation have the greatest impact on industries and the overall economy, and why? (6p)
- 2. Analyze the sources of market failures in the digital economy and how the special characteristics of digital markets may impact on new company entry. (6 p)
- 3. What is Digital Transformation? What kind of requirements it sets for management of business organizations, explain and justify briefly three (3) of them? (5p)
- 4. Briefly describe five (5) typical ways of fostering and organizing innovation. Analyze them each shortly using some applicable framework (either presented in the course or identified outside). (5p)
- 5. What is understood with the Platform Economy? Explain shortly its i) evolution, ii) fundamentals and iii) main impacts for business? (6p)



Individual Assignment (Cont'd)

6. Answer to either A or B: (4p)

A: How emotional and psychological issues can affect management and managers - in terms of devising and executing the strategy of a firm?

B: Why self-management and self-organising are an important option for organising work in digital business organisations?

7. Mini digital transformation case (6p)

The changes in external business environment, such as globalization, digital transformation and platform economy have set new management related challenges for companies. Considering the previous, choose one company (not Apple, Microsoft, Google or Nokia) in the domain of digital business that has had notable challenges and has either failed or succeeded in digitally transforming its business. Discuss briefly the reasons for the challenges and the company's reactions to them. Analyze management's role in the transformation (change management, decisions, strategy changes, etc.).

Overall grading scale (0-5)

0 point: "No actual effort/success"

- Shows little or no thought being given to the tasks;
- Analysis includes a lot of clear contradictions and/or errors;
- Submission is incomplete;

1 point: "Minimum effort/success"

- Task is accomplished without many clear major contradictions or errors;
- All the questions are answered indicating at least some degree of support for the justifications;
- Submission indicates minimum effort for the exercise;

Overall grading scale (Cont'd)

2-3 points: "Average – good" effort and success

- Task is understood and accomplished moderately/well leading into 'credible' result;
- Your answers indicate average/good support for the conclusions with related justifications;
- Submission indicates both average/good effort and quality;

4-5 points: "Very good – excellent" work performance

- Shows in-depth understanding of the related theory and practice;
- Work reflects diligent analysis capabilities and answers give full and coherent support for the actual task;
- Submission indicates both high level of effort and quality;
