

Guidelines for the reflection paper on case Kluuvin Apteekki

Case Kluuvin Apteekki will not be done in case groups. Instead, you need to write an individual reflection paper. The purpose of the reflection paper is to reflect your learnings concerning the case. You should read the case before Friday 3rd November and think how you would solve the problems outlined in the case. Then, we will discuss your approaches on Friday at class. Based on that class discussion you need to write a reflection paper where you discuss how your thinking progressed. The reflection paper is maximum one page.

It is critical that you participate to the discussion at class on Friday 3rd November. Otherwise, it will be difficult for you to reflect upon your learnings.

Grading rubric

Case reflection	Does not provide any information about the learning experience or outcomes.	Provides scarce description of the learning experience. For example: "I learned a lot", "My opinion changed", "I liked the discussion" without elaborating on details of the process.		Provides explanation of what thoughts the author had before the discussion, what are the final thoughts, how the opinion evolved.	Clearly articulates what thoughts the author had before the class discussion and what they learned during the discussion. The report connects the learning experience to some core theoretical discussions around the key topics related to the case and is able to demonstrate key take aways succinctly.
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
