- Deadline: 10:00 Thu April 11th one person returns to MyCourses in PDF format.


Final Presentations

You can use materials from the mid-project presentation to provide context, but mostly this should be an engaging summary of your process and your final concept.

Duration of the presentation is **15 minutes or less.** Rehearse the timings!

Key points of Final Presentation

Key questions that should be explored:


Overview: what is your project all about: Explain what the overarching theme.

Goal: what is it that you were trying to accomplish.

Context: Why is it important, background, problem that is being solved, who is your target audience: Who did you design for?

How did you pursue your goals, what methods were used?

What was the outcome and did it meet your goal?



Grading of Final presentations

Final presentation is graded by points 0–10, based on the:

- Quality of presentation (both visually and verbally)
- Structure: clarity, progression, ease of understanding
- Outcome of the project: quality, extent, relevance
- Discussion of your design process

Score can be reduced for going over the allotted time.

Project report

- Maximum length: 6 + 2 pages of appendices.
- Include in the report at least:
 - a description of your concept,
 - your progress,
 - o the outcome,
 - testing results,
 - your own reflection on the shortcomings and merits of the project, and
 - o future development ideas
- Again, start with a one-paragraph summary that crystallizes your concept, main findings and next steps.
- Use visual material such as mockups, sketches and screenshots.
- Graded 0-10 based on the
 - o quality of writing,
 - structure,
 - documentation of your progress,
 - o argumentation, and
 - o in particular reflection honest assessment of the merits and shortcomings of your work
- Deadline: April 18th
