### **COLLECTIVE RIGHTS MANAGEMENT**

- Collective rights management
  - Means licensing of copyright and related rights by organisations acting on behalf of rights owners
  - Makes it easier for users to acquire licenses and pay remunerations to rightsholders
- Collective management organisations (CMOs)
  - Represents certain group of copyright and related rights owners
  - Facilitate rights clearance in the interest of both parties (rights owners and users)
- CMOs are usually non-profit organisations
- Collective management can be
  - Statutory / mandatory
  - Contractual / voluntary




### WHAT DOES A CMO DO?

### Typically, a CMO:

- monitors when, where and what works are used
- negotiates tariffs and other conditions with users
- licenses the use of protected works on behalf of rightsholders it represents
- collects the fees from users
- distributes remuneration to the rightsholders



### ADVANTAGES OF COLLECTIVE MANAGEMENT





### **CMO'S IN FINLAND**

- 1. APFI is a copyright society for audiovisual producers.
- 2. Avate represents screenwriters, directors and actors and one main purpose is to promote collective agreements in audiovisual field.
- **3. Gramex** is a copyright association for performing artists and recording producers.
- **4. Kopiosto** is an umbrella organisation for authors, performing artists and publishers.
- 5. Kuvasto is a copyright society for visual artists.
- **6. Teosto** is a copyright society for composers, lyricists, arrangers and music publishers.
- 7. Sanasto is a copyright society for writers and translators of literary works, and its main purpose is to manage public lending rights behalf of writers and translators.







## AVEK - THE PROMOTION CENTRE FOR AUDIOVISUAL CULTURE


Supports versatile Finnish audiovisual culture using copyright funds

### **KOPIOSTO AUTHORISATION**



### WHAT DOES THE AUTHORISATION INCLUDE?

### Licensing

 The right to grant licenses, enter into agreements and collect compensation on behalf of the rightsholders

### **Distribution of remuneration**

Individual or collective distribution

### **Monitoring rights**

 Removing unauthorizes material from e.g. the Internet



### **KOPIOSTO'S MANDATE**

Over 80 000 authors, performers, publishers and other rightsholders

Rightsholder transfers the mandate to one Kopiosto's member organisation by the Copyright Agreement or the Grant of Rights The member organisation transfer the management of the rights to Kopiosto

Kopiosto grants licenses, distributes remunerations and defend copyrights.

### KOPIOSTO'S LICENSES BASED ON MANDATES

### Direct mandates from rightsholders – represented righsholders

- Domestic repertuary
  - Over 80 000 mandates (a power of attorney or an agreement)
  - 44 member organisations representing different creative fields
- Foreign repertuary
  - Mandate based on reciprocal agreements with foreign CMO
  - Kopiosto has reciprocal agreements with 35 foreign CMOs in audiovisual field and with 27 foreign CMO's in reprographic field

#### Non-represented rightsholders


- If there are an extended collective license (ECL) section in the Copyright Act
  - A license agreement will be extended to apply to the rights of rightholders who have not authorised the CMO to represent them
  - CMO need to have an approved by ministry to operate as an extended collective licensing organisations
  - Kopiosto has ministry's approval in many area of the ECL



### EXTENDED COLLECTIVE LICENSING (ECL)

- Based on the Copyright Act (Section 26)
- Operating as an extended collective licensing organisation
  - requires an approval by the Ministry of Education and Culture
  - CMO should be, on the basis of its mandates, sufficiently representative of rightholders
  - the Ministry approves the organisation for a fixed period (max 5 years)
- Makes it possible for CMO to grant licences also on behalf of nonrepresented authors
  - All rightholders are guaranteed equal treatment
    - A non-represented rightsholder are entitled to remunerations from CMO
  - A rightsholder may at any time easily and effectively exclude their works or other subject matter from the license



  - AV12 Use in online content sharing services
  - No licensing, yet


