

Course Design (5 cr)

General description

During the course, you will work with one of the courses you teach. You will analyse the current state of the course based on the principles of constructive alignment and prepare a plan for developing and improving the course. Peer support and feedback are central elements of the course.

The course includes contact teaching days, sessions for discussing course plans, independent, pair and peer group assignments, online assignments and peer feedback.

- Student-centred and learning-orientated approach to course planning
- Core content analysis
- Designing learning outcomes
- Time allocation and workload
- Assessment and teaching methods
- Teaching and learning from the viewpoint of expertise
- Evaluating teaching and utilising feedback in developing one's own teaching
- Giving constructive feedback to other participants and receiving feedback

After the course, you will be able to:

- analyse your own teaching based on the principles of aligned teaching
- plan and design your own teaching as a part of curriculum planning and based on a student-centred and learning-orientated approach, taking into account the principles of aligned teaching and the special characteristics of your own field
- assess the effects of different pedagogical choices and decisions and apply different pedagogical solutions in your own teaching
- give constructive feedback to other participants and receive feedback from other participants
