Structure of studies

PROGRAMME COMMON STUDIES 15 CR

It is highly recommended to complete during the first year. The common studies courses are often prerequisites for the advanced studies courses.

MAJOR STUDIES	45 CR
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(common major studies + advanced studies)

MASTER'S THESIS 30 CR

ELECTIVE STUDIES 30 CR



Master's thesis

- The Master's thesis (30 cr) is written on a topic related to the topics studied during the Master's programme.
- The professors of the programme provide Master's thesis topics that are related to their current research activities.
- The student can also suggest their own topic to the desired supervisor.

Elective studies

For your free elective studies (30 cr) you can study courses offered by Aalto University or by other universities as it is possible by Aalto internal and interinstitutional agreements and procedures and course specific prerequisites.

Electives may include for example:

- Minor
- Exchange studies
- Additional courses in your degree programme or major
- Studies from other programmes and majors
- Studies at other universities
- Practical training
- <u>Language and communication studies</u> (please note the language requirements of the degree)



Language studies

Language studies are included in students' elective studies and are agreed in the personal study plan (HOPS).

- 1) If you have completed your bachelor's degree in Finland AND your language of education is Finnish or Swedish:
- -> If the language studies have not been completed in the Bachelor's degree, you must take 2 ECTS in the second national language and 3 ECTS in one foreign language, including oral and written proficiency.
- -> If the language studies have been completed in the Bachelor's degree, you do not need to take language studies
- 2) If you have completed your bachelor's degree abroad AND your language of education is not Finnish or Swedish:
- -> Choose 3 credits of language courses (for example Finnish or Swedish (link))

Credit transfer

Credit transfer means counting studies completed outside Aalto University towards your Aalto degree by either using them to substitute for an individual Aalto course or study module; including them in the degree for example as elective studies or have learning gained outside formal education accredited as credits towards your degree.

Study plan in Sisu

- The personal study plan describes the individual study path you intend to follow to complete your degree.
- The degree structure of your Master's programme forms the basis for your study plan, but there is room for individual choices, especially for elective studies.


