

Personal Study Plan & Course Registration

- Demonstration in Sisu go to sisu.aalto.fi
- Aalto courses are automatically on your study plan – Aachen & MUL courses will be added by admins once credits are transfered
- No need to submit for approval if you don't make any exceptions to the standard structure
- Laboratory safety course CHEM-E0140





EMC student's checklist to Aalto throughout studies

- Keep your contact information and IT account up to date and valid (Sisu / My Profile / Personal Information) <u>studies-eng@aalto.fi</u>)
 - Finnish ID number (remember EU Registration)*
- Follow your aalto.fi e-mails or auto-forward to your primary email
- Enroll to the university every academic year in order to keep your student status
 - Enrolment period May August
- You can enroll either as attending or non-attending (nonattending only for the semesters II and III) EXCEPT when you have a mobility scholarship **
- Enrolling as attending requires a payment of the Student Union (AYY) membership fee and healthcare fee to KELA





Master's thesis


- Plan and agree about your MSc thesis topic with professors at all three universities
- Depending on your MSc thesis topic and supervising professor at Aalto, you will either continue as a student of Aalto ENG or move to Aalto CHEM and graduate from there
- When doing your MSc thesis and until graduation, you must be enrolled as attending at Aalto
- Aalto Scholarships = tuition fee waivers (those granted one at admission)
 - If your main supervisor is from Aalto, you will be granted a scholarship for your 4th term





Residence permits & registration

- Students from outside EU apply for students' residence permit before coming to Finland. More information: https://enterfinland.fi/eServices/info/studypermit
 - If you didn't get a personal ID code with your residence permit, please register at DVV to get it (Thursday DVV pop up)
- Students from EU register their residence at the MIGRI if the study period in Finland will exceed 3 months (fee 52 eur). More information: https://migri.fi/en/eu-citizen
- → Finnish Personal ID code
- You need the personal ID-code for instance for opening a mobile phone connection or a bank account, or for HSL app. It makes even enrolment at the university easier. More information: https://dvv.fi/en/moving-to-finland



Finnish ID (number)

- Required e.g. for student healthcare, public transportation, bank account, employment (taxation)...
- How to get it?
 - With residence permit (non-EU/EEA students)
 - By application to DVV (non-EU/EEA student who did not get it with residence permit)
 - By registration of right of residence (EU/EEA students) to Migri
- Once you get it, send it to us (<u>jointmasters-eng@aalto.fi</u>) and we will add it to your Sisu profile.



Healthcare

- YTHS = Finnish Student Healthcare Services (FSHS)
 - Compulsory service fee, no costs for appointments
 - Payment due 15 November, instructions at <u>How to pay the student</u> <u>healthcare fee | Our Services | Kela</u> (N.B: You must pay before you can access the services – you might need them before 15 Nov!)
 - EU students may be exempted (apply for exemption ASAP)
 - Always the first recommendation = affordable and easy
 - Office hours only
- Public healthcare (e.g. Tapiola Health Centre)
 - Only emergencies
 - Remember European Health Insurance Card!
- Private cliniques (e.g. Terveystalo, Mehiläinen...)
 - Non-emergencies outside office hours
 - Make sure you know where to go & what to do in case of emergency
 - Reimbursement claims with your insurance
 - In emergencies, call 112



HSL card & student discount

- App. 40% discount in public transportation
- In order to get the discount, you should
 - Get the student discount form for EXCHANGE STUDENTS with an official university stamp and signature from the Starting Point (Otakaari 1)
 - Visit a the HSL pop-up desk at the Welcome Fair or HSL service point
- The discount can be granted for the period that you have currently enrolled as attending for, i.e. the whole academic year 1 August 2024 to 31 July 2025







Bank accounts

- Aalto does not have a bank partner or recommendation – other (international) students and tutors know the best tips
- Book an appointment at the bank where you want to open account in advance
- Finnish personal ID code is required
- Online banking codes strongly recommended if only you can get them

Mobility scholarships

- You can apply for mobility scholarship (e.g. Erasmus+) from Aalto to Aachen in January
- We will send you the detailed instructions when the application period begins
- Mobility scholarships for the semester at Leoben are granted by Aachen and the application period is also in January

- ☐ Getting a Finnish personal ID → inform us when you do
- ☐ Paying student healthcare fee or applying for exemption
