General info about master's thesis

- 30 cr + maturity test (0 cr) ~ half a year
 - Recorded with special codes, no registration needed
 - Abstract serves as the maturity test
 - Thesis topic must be agreed with the supervisor & approved officially through MyStudies
- Thesis must follow Aalto guidelines
 - Applies also to international joint programmes
- Grading 1 to 5
 - Familiarize yourself with the evaluation form!
- Some differences between different master's programmes
 - Always follow the instructions of your own programme!



General info about master's thesis

- Master's thesis is a public document!
 - Do not include any confidential material
- Need help with writing the thesis?

 - Thesis and Tomatoes (co-writing sessions)



Ethical questions: Plagiarsm, Al


- Remember to follow <u>Aalto University Code of Academic Integrity</u>

Master's thesis management functionality on MyStudies

On MyStudies Thesis Management functionality, you will:

- 1.Start a thesis process.
- 2. Provide basic information about your thesis.
- 3. Apply for supervisor & topic approval.
- 4. Store thesis metadata.
- 5. Submit thesis for evaluation, approval and archiving.



Thesis supervising

Supervisor (valvoja in Finnish):

- Must be Aalto professor or senior/principal university lecturer
- Usually from your own programme
- If you wish to have a supervisor from outside your programme, discuss with the programme director

Advisor(s) (ohjaaja(t) in Finnish):

- 1-2 advisors
- Minimum requirement: master's degree
- For example, someone from the company, if company is involved

Thesis from a supervisor's perspective



What an MSc thesis is?

"The key goal of the master's thesis is **solving a problem relevant to the field of study** based on existing scientific knowledge in compliance with the principles of responsible conduct of research.

The goal is to produce a scientific thesis."



What an MSc thesis is?

"The success of the master's thesis is evaluated in terms of its success in, e.g. the following:

- identifying a significant and important research problem
- defining the <u>research problem</u> (research question);
- defining the scientific/<u>theoretical framework</u> for the work by finding the relevant sources;
- defining the <u>research methods</u> and empirical material;
- defining the concrete research frame;
- defining the <u>nature of the new knowledge</u> produced and identifying of the <u>relevance and merits</u> of the study and
- the novelty of the research and the innovativeness of its solutions"



What an MSc thesis is?

Not just any written report on a given topic – an MSc thesis has very specific goals and requirements

Especially important to remember, if you do the thesis for a company



Supervision (my take)

- Supervisor helps to <u>define the path</u> for the thesis especially important early in the process
- Supervisor primarily an expert in the <u>research</u> <u>process</u>, sometimes also in the substance
- <u>Division of labour</u> between advisors and the supervisor
- Double role of the supervisor
- Supervisor a <u>resource</u> for the student



What to pay attention to

- Well defined <u>research questions</u> essential to guide the work – key engine of the narrative of the thesis
- Develop a rough <u>timeline</u> for your thesis project and update/upgrade it when necessary
- Have a generic thesis <u>outline</u> from the start and add notes, granularity during the project
- Formalities matter, familiarize yourself with the marking criteria – and do it early in the process

- Be active!
- Job teaser, company web pages, recruitment events (e.g. Aalto Talent expo or Summer Job Day)

Schedule, more freedom with the topic...



Schedule

Deadlines:

- Thesis topic must be approved before the acceptance of the thesis
- Thesis presentation completed
- Final version of the thesis sent for evaluation.
- If you have completed all the studies and apply for graduation DL date = graduation date

IMPORTANT: Agree the schedule with the supervisor! The supervisor needs time to evaluate

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Thesis process

Search for topic & supervisor

Agree on the topic with a supervisor → Official topic approval needed!

 It is recommended that you approve for the topic as soon as it is fixed with the supervisor. Do it *latest 1 month* before finishing the thesis

Work – work – work: writing your thesis

Agree the schedule of the final stages of the thesis with your supervisor

Thesis presentation (see the instructions of your own programme!)

Maturity test

Thesis approval

Graduation



Double degree programme specifics

Check your student agreement or other possible guidelines & requirements of your programme in terms of...

- Environment (university or industry? Can you choose?)
- Topic (Should it connect to your major / study track?)
- Location (At exit university? Anywhere in the world? In Europe?)
- Timeline (Hard deadlines at partner universities? Tuition fee consequences? Joint graduation ceremony, requirements to attend?)
- Partner university role (how much is the partner university involved in the process? Should you have your topic approved there? Do you need a supervisor? Will they evaluate your thesis independently or simply incorporate the Aalto evaluation? Do you have to attend a defense at the partner university or is Aalto thesis presentation sufficient? Any requirements to publicity of your thesis and archiving the thesis document? How do you submit your thesis to the partner university?)
- Thesis document (do you need a separate cover page for the partner university? How to give credit to your programme and partner university?)
