
Welcome to study urban experiences!



Dear student Welcome to study urban experiences! I hope you had a very relaxing Christmas holiday!

I am Marketta Kyttä, a professor of land use planning in the department of Built Environment in Aalto. Because my background is in environmental psychology I am very happy to teach this course which is all about human experiences in urban environments.

We will start the contact sessions during the second week of January. Before that you will have a pre-task. Here I will give you the instructions for that.

Before the course starts, you should...

Indentify a place that is personally meaningful for you

 Positive or negative urban place experience

Identify a place that is personally meaningful for you

It can be a positive or negative urban place experience, that is meaningful for you for a variety of reasons

- It can be a smaller scale place or a larger area
- The place can be in Finland or elsewhere
- It can be related to whatever part of your life



Your first task will be to describe the place that you choose:

- Use maps, photographs, drawings, video or text to describe the place itself. What is the place like physically?
- Tell about your own place experience. Why is the place meaningful to you?
- Make a Power Point presentation with two slides (no more!):
 - Use the first slide for describing the place and another slide for explaining why the place is meaningful for you.
- OR: make a short video (max 3 min)



Your next task is to study independently the virtual material that I have saved in My courses web page in the Materials section.

There are short online lectures about the following 6 themes:

- Aesthetic experiences
- Sense of community
- Perceived safety
- Restorative environments
- Childfriendly Environments
- Place attachment

You are supposed to watch all these six short videos. It will take about 2 hours. In the Materials folder, there are also PDFs about all of these presentation – so please use them if you rather read than watch these videos.

Then ...

Select one theme that you will look more closely. Reflect your personal place experience. Write this reflection to the

third slide of your presentation.



Then:

Select one theme that is most relevant in relation to your own place experience.

Please read the additional material provided about this theme: Articles that are provided in My courses. The minimum is one article.


Reflect your personal place experience in the light of existing research on this theme.

- Is your experience in line with research about that theme?
- In what ways your experience differs?

Write a third page to your Power Point presentation about these reflections.


During the first contact session...
