





Average price of PV modules (\$/Wp)




CHILDREN DYING

Percent dying before their fifth birthday



Countries with death penalty (of 194)






New HIV infections per million people


LEADED GASOLINE Countries allowing lead in gasoline (of 194) 193





Deaths per 10 billion passenger miles (5-year averages) 9 2,100 1929-33






SMALLPOX

Countries with smallpox cases (of 194)




OZONE DEPLETION 1,000 tons ozone-depleting substances used




CHILD LABOR

Share of children aged 5-14 who work full time under bad conditions




NUCLEAR ARMS

1,000s of nuclear warheads




SMOKE PARTICLES

Kg SO₂ particles emitted per person







Share of adults (15+) with basic skills to read and write










Share of humanity living in democracy


5 year survival of those diagnosed before age 20, with best treatment


















PLANE CRASH DEATHS

Deaths per 10 billion passenger miles (5-year averages)







NUMBER OF PEOPLE BY INCOME AND REGION


Each cube is 100 million people, colored by region.
