- · Joukon Voima is a crowdfunding service for sustainable projects
- · We offer companies loan based funding with which they implement project that contribute to sustainable development goals
- Our objective is to provide ordinary people with impact investing opportunities where alongside financial returns they can create a positive, measurable environmental or social impact.



Background for the research

- · Joukon Voima is negotiating with a wind power project developer on crowdfunding their wind power park in Finland
 - · ~500k€ quota to be crowdfunded: 3 year loan term, 5,0% annual interest
 - · The crowdfunding campaign to take place in the early summer or the early autumn 2019
- The project company seeks ways to engage the local citizens and provide them with a chance to financially benefit from the project
- Even though the crowdfunded capital is more expensive than what is available from more traditional sources, the project company values the **BENEFITS** of engaging the local community

Assignment

- · We are curious on finding out what kind of reactions can we expect when providing the local community a chance to invest in the wind project
 - · What kind of expectations do locals have for the investment opportunity?
 - · Is their perceptions more positive towards the wind project due to the inclusive approach or do they think this is questionable resulting in negative reactions?
 - · How do the locals perceive the overall ownership (local, Finnish, foreign) of the project?

· DELIVERABLE:

We expect to gain implications and suggestions for making our future crowdfunding campaign more attractive to the local community and this to result in greater benefits for our project partner



Assignment

- · The research method to be defined together with the research group:
 - Boring, but useful literature review?
 - · Interviewing or surveying the local community?
 - · Surveying the communities of past comparable international projects?
- · The current issue is that the project partner has not disclosed all necessary information
 - Still unclear, when would we gain an access and permission to be in touch with the local community
 - · This shall be clarified within a week or two
