## How to choose a topic?

#### What interests you?

- E.g., from your perspective as a consumer/user
- E.g., from your perspective as a part of a company selling goods/services
- E.g., from your perspective as a member of a social group



# What is a "good" topic?

- = A topic that enables you to generate new knowledge
- A "real-world problem", i.e. one that practitioners/ users/consumers face,
- That is relevant to a large audience (e.g., not only to users of carsharing service car2go, but to users of carsharing services in general/ not only to carsharing users in Finland, but also elsewhere),
- That is an area, which has already been researched,
- AND that tackles a research gap



# Where to look for topic ideas?

- Hot topics in media, e.g., blogs, magazines, newspapers, news
- Lectures, lecture materials
- Practitioners' problems
  - At your own work
  - As reported in media etc.
- Peers' problems in e.g., using a product
  - Talk to friends, family
  - Look in online communities, blogs, etc.
- Voids in research, e.g., look at the section avenues for future research of scientific articles

#### Target phenomena:

- Peer-to-peer
   Professional services
- Discounts and Free Gifts

#### Research question:

Are discounts and free gifts effective in stimulating usage of peer-to-peer rental services?



# If you can't decide on a thesis topic, you may want to look into these:

- Product packaging materials as drivers of consumption behavior
- Barriers of sharing economy
- Sustainable consumption
  - Food consumption (sustainable food styles and diets)
  - Eco-labeling
  - Anti-consumption movements (voluntary simplicity, minimalism)
- The benefits of online gaming communities
- New frontiers in retail, e.g., social media as a retail tool
