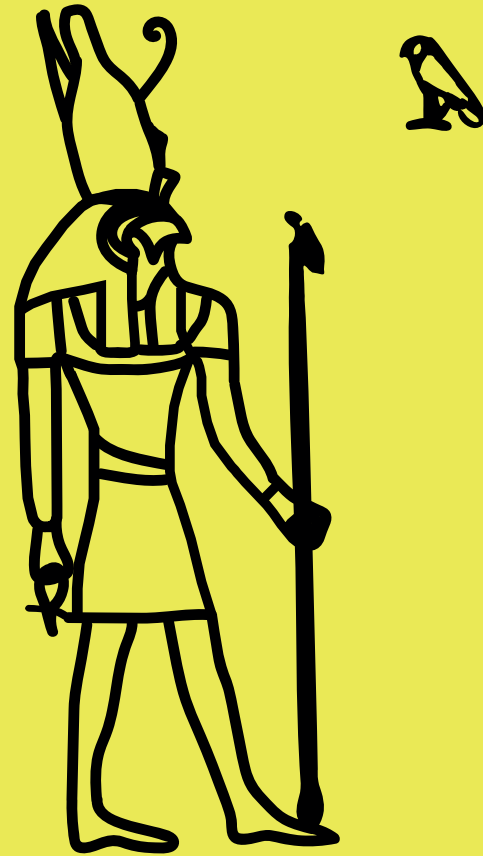


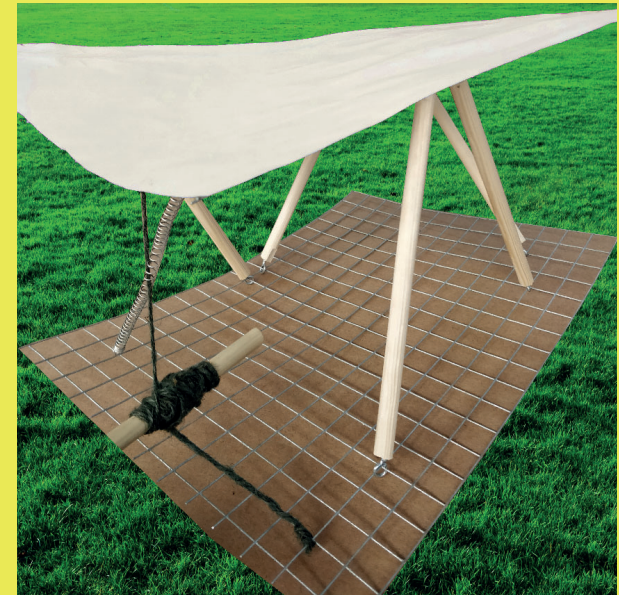
Horus

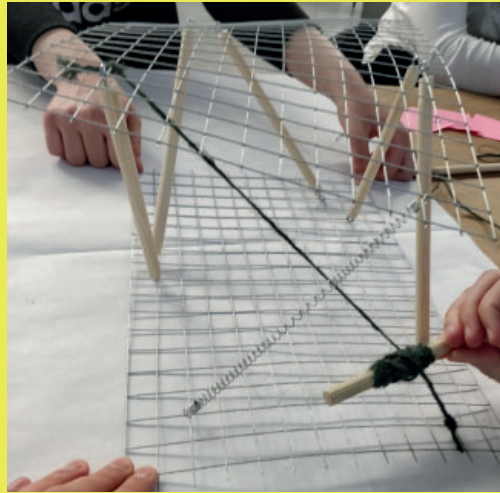
